As of June 21 I am resigning from youth ministry in general and CSSM specifically.

Why June 21st? I picked the date solely because it is the last day of school and since my ministry is based on the school calendar it made sense.

Later I realized that June 21 will mark 20 years of following Jesus to the day. As a 9 year old on June 21, 1993 I was sitting by the creek behind our house thinking and I realized that I couldn't 'do' Christianity on my own; I couldn't be good enough. So I prayed a simple prayer asking Jesus to do it for me then went inside and read Psalm 62. "He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be greatly shaken." (v.2)

Not much changed physically or even how I felt emotionally but in the cosmic realms I was transferred from "the domain of darkness" into "the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins." Colossians 1:13,14

As of June, almost half of my Christian life will have been spent in vocational youth ministry (9 years, almost 6 with CSSM Ministries). It is bittersweet to move on.

Because 'ministry' has been such a big part of my life it's a little hard to think of 'not doing ministry' anymore. But regardless of my occupation, one thing hasn't changed: I'm an ordinary person getting to know an extraordinary God and wanting to point others to Him.
